

## FFCC Heads to Africa

In the country of Kenya, one-third of the population does not have access to drinking water and nearly two-thirds lack basic sanitation.<sup>1</sup> The issue is particularly difficult in the rural areas like in the village of Kisaani.

This January, FFCC is sending a team to break ground on a much needed well for the Kisaani community. FFCC is partnering with Kisaani, the regional government and a Kenyan organization to accomplish this effort.

Once FFCC has completed its work in Kenya, the team will travel to Tanzania where they will continue to provide help to the most vulnerable. One stop on their trip will be to deliver a wheelchair to Yohana, a young man disabled by polio. The team also plans to meet with local and national leaders as we continue to work together to improve education, job creation and access to basic needs such as safe water, sufficient food and medical care.
