NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE

Featuring The Gaylord Opryland Hotel & Grand Ole Opry

6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

Day 1 - Depart from your hometown aboard your motorcoach and head south toward Tennessee with a lunch stop on your own along the way. Arrive at your overnight stop for check-in (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2 - Breakfast, then continue to **Nashville - The Home of Country Music** where you will check into the famous **Gaylord Opryland Hotel** and have a chance to become acquainted with this magnificent complex. Tonight, enjoy dinner and an entertaining show at the **Texas Troubadour Theater**. John Beardsley's hit show, "A Tribute to the King Through the Years" pays tribute to the King in Music City where Elvis recorded over 300 songs. This high energy live musical biography transports the audience through six phases of his career with over 30 songs and costume changes.

Day 3 - After breakfast, meet your guide for a **tour of Nashville**. You will see the homes of well known country and western entertainers as well as the Ryman Theater, the original home of the Grand Ole Opry which is known as the Mother Church of Country Music. A photo stop will be made at the **Parthenon**, which is the world's only full scale replica of the original Parthenon in Athens. Today the Parthenon functions as an art museum and stands as the centerpiece in Centennial Park. A stop will also be made at the **Upper Room Chapel**. After the tour, return to the **Opryland Hotel** where you will have time to explore at your own pace. Enjoy dinner before departing for a fabulous show at the **Grand Ole Opry**. The Grand Ole Opry blends the excitement of a live audience, the heritage of the world's longest-running live radio show, and an incredible mix of talent.

Day 4 - Enjoy breakfast, then depart for downtown Nashville for a self-guided tour of the **Country Music Hall of Fame**, a state of the art cultural landmark and the world's largest music museum. The museum features an array of rare costumes, instruments, historical mementos and tear-stained lyric sheets which serve to entertain and educate audiences from all over the world. Afterwards, you may enjoy lunch on your own and free time in downtown Nashville. Visit the Honky Tonks on Broadway, a breeding ground for hopeful performers, musicians, and songwriters. While in the downtown area, enjoy a **self-guided tour of the Ryman Auditorium**, the original home of the Grand Ole Opry. Return to your hotel to freshen up before continuing to the **Nashville Nightlife Dinner Theater** where you will enjoy a wonderful buffet dinner and Nashville's newest production, "The Best of Country Music." Experience a celebration of Country Music from both past and present. Hear songs from many of the great artists in Country Music history along with today's hottest hits.

Day 5 - Following breakfast, check out and depart for a tour of **RCA Studio B**, home of 1,000 hits and where Elvis recorded over 200 songs; it is now on the National Register of Historic Places. After your visit, depart for your overnight stop to check into your hotel (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 6 - After breakfast, check out and continue homeward - taking with you fond memories of the **Opryland Hotel & Nashville, TN!**
