



Tour Itinerary: From Rome to London, experience five of Western Europe's beautiful countries! In Italy, discover the ancient history of Rome and enjoy the rolling hills and rural villages of Tuscany. Admire the alpine mountains and deep blue lakes in Switzerland and Austria. In France, drive past some of Burgundy's most famous vineyards and stand in awe of the Eiffel Tower in Paris. Travel on the Eurostar train to royal London, England, and explore its wonderful treasures.

Day 1, Wed., September 5: Depart Chicago. Depart from O'Hare Airport on your overnight flight to Italy.

Day 2, Thu., September 6: Welcome to Rome! Check into your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to explore this lively ancient capital. In the afternoon, meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers.

Day 3, Fri., September 7: Rome. The "Eternal City" is steeped in history, vibrantly alive, exciting and absolutely unique! Sightseeing with a Local Guide starts with St. Peter's Square and Basilica. Other highlights are the iconic Colosseum, the largest amphitheater ever built and Circus Maximus. Day 4, Sat., September 8: Rome-Pisa-Florence. Vistas of rolling hills, austere rows of cypress trees, terraced vineyards, olive groves and rural villages form the backdrop of your journey through Tuscany. Take a break in Pisa enjoy a ride on a mini train to see the **Square of Miracles** and the amazing Leaning Tower. Overnight in fabulous Florence. (B,D)

Day 5, Sun., September 9: Florence-Venice Area. Birthplace of the Renaissance, Florence was for centuries a leading power. Let your Local Guide take you on a walking tour to discover the landmarks of this amazing city, including Piazza Signoria with the Loggia dei Lanzi, Palazzo Vecchio, and the breathtaking cathedral on Piazza del Duomo.



Later, watch how leather is embossed with gold, and enjoy free time to shop. In the afternoon, drive north across the Po River and spend two nights in the Venice area. (B)

Day 6, Mon., September 10: Venice Area. Venice is known worldwide for its carnival, its film festival, and its incredible location on the water. Today, reach Venice by private MOTORBOAT to view the Bridge of Sighs, Doges' Palace, and St. Mark's Square before a visit to a local **Glassblowing Workshop**. Don't miss out on the optional gondola trip, gliding along the picturesque canals with a local troubadour who will serenade you. (B,D)



Day 7, Tue., September 11: Venice Area-Cortina-Innsbruck Area, Austria. Leave the plains of the Veneto region behind and drive northwards to spot the spectacular peaks of the DOLOMITES. Stop awhile in Cortina to enjoy the grand scenery, and later cross over the Europa Bridge and Brenner Pass into Austria to reach Innsbruck just in time to see the famous **Golden Roof**, an emblem of the city. (B)

Day 8, Wed., September 12: Innsbruck Area-Liechtenstein-Lucerne, Switzerland. Drive through the valleys and villages of the mountainous Tyrol to the Arlberg Tunnel, descending into Switzerland. Stop briefly in Vaduz, Liechtenstein's capital, absorb the majestic alpine scenery and glimpses of Lake Walen on your way to Lucerne. (B)



Day 9, Thu., September 13: Lucerne. One of Switzerland's finest cities, Lucerne is nestled amid the snowcapped Alps, surrounded by its lake, and embellished by the clear mountain waters of the Reuss River. The orientation tour includes the **Lion Monument**, erected in memory of the 800 Swiss Guards who defended Louis XVI and his wife. Also see the famous wooden **Chapel Bridge**. Enjoy free time or choose from a grand selection of optional activities to complete the day: a cable-car ride to the 10,000-foot summit of Mount Titlis, a cruise on the fjord-like lake, or time to shop for an authentic Swiss watch. (B,D)



Day 10, Fri., September 14: Lucerne-Paris, France. Enjoy vistas of green pastures and rustic chalets, then cross into France and drive past some of its most famous Burgundy vineyards as you make your way into Paris. Get a taste of Parisian joie de vivre at an optional cabaret show. (B)

Day 11, Sat., September 15: Paris. Paris is a world-class city that probably has more familiar landmarks than almost any other city in the world. This morning, see them all during the included city tour with a Local Guide. Later, feel like a French aristocrat on the optional walking tour through the opulent Palace of Versailles. Tonight, you might consider joining an optional farewell dinner in a typical French restaurant. (B)



Day 12, Sun., September 16: Paris-London, England.

Relax on your **EUROSTAR** journey to London. (B)

Day 13, Mon., September 17: London. Your vacation ends

with breakfast this morning. Or, ask us about adding another night or two in this fabulous city! (B)



TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport that is valid for six months beyond the return date of the tour. Complete passport name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Tours. Most major credit cards are also accepted. A deposit of **\$300 per person** (+ Cosmos insurance premium if you choose to buy that) is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by June 18, 2019.**

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations are subject to a \$50 Burkhalter Tours service fee that may not be covered by tour operator insurance. In addition to the service fee and possible airline penalties, tour cancellation penalties are as follows: 120+ days prior to departure: Service Fee. 119-65 days prior: Deposit; 64-22 days prior: 20%; 21-8 days prior: 30%; 7-1 days prior: 50%; departure day and later: 100% non-refundable. No refund will apply on unused portions of the tour. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel Insurance is strongly advised in order to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation/interruption/delay, and medical emergency expenses is available from Cosmos for \$229.00 (\$289.00 single). Other plans may also be available. Ask your agent for information.

Tour Conditions: This tour is a regular Cosmos departure and no minimum number of Burkhalter travelers is required for the tour to operate. With 20 paid travelers, a Burkhalter Tours host may accompany the group to provide additional service throughout the tour. All arrangements are based upon tariffs in effect on date of brochure production and are subject to change. Once deposit has been received, any changes to air or land arrangements may be assessed a \$50 revision fee. Revision fees may be higher once air is ticketed. Itinerary is subject to change by the tour operator.

Air Transportation: The airfare portion of the tour price is an estimate and is subject to change. Airline seat assignments can only be requested after final payment and may be limited in availability. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations. Deviations from the group air schedule may result in a different airfare. Routing and schedules are subject to change.

Accommodations/Transportation: Tour hotels are superior tourist or first class properties with private ensuite facilities. Rooms typically have two beds. Hotels are subject to change. Touring coaches are deluxe vehicles with panoramic windows and seats that partially recline. Single travelers are allocated one seat only.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to climb stairs and board a motorcoach in a timely manner, and walk moderate distances, sometimes over uneven ground. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them—tour personnel cannot and will not provide such assistance.
