Enjoy a wonderful summer afternoon in Historic Kenosha! Begin your day with a wonderful tour of the four historic districts, three which are on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy the sites of the Library Park District, Third Avenue which is considered Kenosha's "mansion" district. The Civic Center historic district which features Neoclassical government, museum and school buildings constructed in a new Civic Center following the World's Fair in Chicago. Enjoy a delicious buffet lunch at the Boathouse Pub & Eatery with views of Lake Michigan.



Next spend time in Kenosha's Civil War Museum. The Civil War Museum is like no other Civil War museum in the country. The Museum focuses on the Civil War from the perspective of the people of the seven states of the upper middle west: Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, and

Wisconsin. These seven states sent over one million men to serve in the Union army while providing much of the food and raw materials necessary for the northern states to carry on the war. Through the use of personal stories and narratives, the Museum also explores how the Civil War impacted the people on the Western home front before, during, and after the war by connecting the prewar causes to the postwar effects.

End your Historic Kenosha adventure on a beautifully restored electric streetcar! Travel a 2-mile loop, providing a scenic tour of the Lake Michigan shoreline, including two historic districts, Harbor Park, the downtown business district and the METRA train station.
