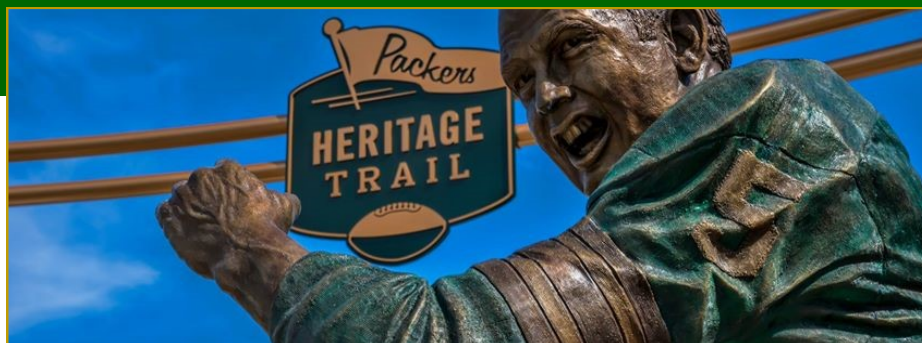


“A Century of Football”

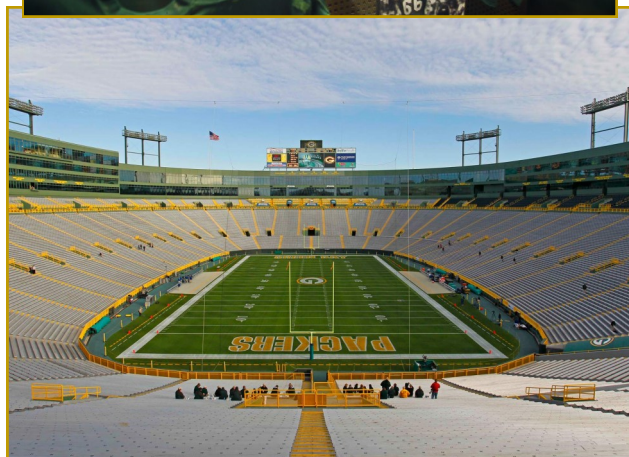
For those who bleed the green and gold, this is the ultimate tour!
