Founded by Thomas Reid in 1769, Falmouth flourished as a market center and port for forty years at a time when Jamaica was the world's leading sugar producer. The town was meticulously planned from the start, with wide streets in a regular grid, adequate water supply, and public buildings. It even had piped water before New York City.

TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

I.D./Citizenship: Travelers must possess a passport valid for at least six months beyond the tour dates with names matching those on their tour and flight reservations. Complete name, gender and birth date are required to confirm reservations per TSA/airline requirements.

Deposits and Payments: Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Travel. Most major credit cards are also accepted at the indicated rate. **A deposit of \$300 per person** is required to secure reservations. All tour confirmations are subject to receipt of signed tour application and payment verification. **Final payment is due by or before July 1, 2019.**

Cancellations/Refunds: This tour is based on a minimum of 46 passengers traveling together. If there are not enough travelers, Burkhalter Travel may have to cancel the tour or adjust the pricing. Tour cancellation penalties are as follows:

Prior to July 1, 2019—Cruise refundable

After July 1, 2019—Cruise is non-refundable

No refund will apply on unused portions of the trip. If a roommate cancels, the remaining traveler may have to pay any single room supplement that is incurred. Name changes and departure date changes are considered reservation cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees. Once issued, airline tickets are 100% non-refundable.

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance to protect your investment. Coverage for trip cancellation, interruption, delay and medical emergency is available. Ask your travel agent for details.

Air transportation: The airfare portion of the tour pricing is subject to change until ticketed. Airline schedules are subject to change by the airlines at any time. Group seat assignments are usually done by the airline for the entire group, and changes are subject to availability, which may be limited. If specific seat assignments are vital to your enjoyment of the tour, we recommend individual air reservations rather than booking with the group.

Accommodations: Hotel and Cruise cabins are first class and moderate first class. Rooms generally have two beds and private bath/shower.

Transfers: Transportation from airport to hotel and port and back to the airport are included.

Traveler Fitness: Travelers should be in reasonably good health, able to board a motorcoach in a timely manner, climb stairs and walk moderate distances over sometimes uneven ground. Individuals with physical and/or cognitive limitations must be accompanied by an able individual who will assume complete responsibility for them. Tour personnel and hosts cannot and will not provide this kind of assistance.
