SEPT 23 | ARRIVE PUGLIA

SEPT 25 | MATERA

Today visit Matera, the Capital of Culture. Join a local guide on a guided tour as we explore this unique and historic town. Later, return to the masseria for an evening of relaxation or exploration at your leisure.

SEPT 26 | ALBEROBELLO - LECCE

Venture to the city of Alberobello, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its charming cone-topped trulli. This afternoon on the way from Alberobello to Lecce, stop for a wine tasting and winery visit experience with lunch. Transfer to our hotel in Lecce, home for the next three nights. (L)
